What are Youth-Centered Permanency Roundtables (YCPRTs)?

YCPRTs put youth at the center of important meetings designed to lead to lifelong connections, with the goal of establishing legal permanency.

- Youth actively participate and help to drive the process.
- They invite the important people in their lives to join the meetings.
- During the process, youth have support in building lifelong connections to expedite legal permanency.



What do youth have to say about YCPRTs?

Youth felt like Facilitators show a lot of respect for their wishes and opinions.

Some respect



Youth reported high satisfaction with the YCPRT meetings.

Neither satisfied nor dissatisfied





Youth found Facilitators easy to understand.

Somewhat easy



Youth felt like they could talk about things that are important to them at YCPRT.

Welcome to the Table

Youth

YCPRTs are about making sure youth have the people -the relationships - that they want and need in their life. Young people deserve to never experience "aging out" of anything.

Supports

Make sure the youth's voice drives the direction of the conversation. They are valued. They are trusted. *Adult Supporters* do not need to be a permanency option.

Professionals

Several key participants make each YCPRT possible. Youth are at the head of the table. However, everybody at the permanency roundtable is essential to the program working.



Youth: At the Center of the Process







- Involve youth & their supports
- Engage ALL family & find fathers
- Facilitate connections to build network
- Breakdown myths & barriers
- Unpack the "No"
- Generate creative ideas (e.g.: circle back)
